A bridge to Karuta

 FROM JAPAN is known as a pioneer in promoting creative Karuta(card game) as an educational, community building tool outside of Japan

What is Karuta?

- Karuta is a traditional, Japanese educational card game around a theme, using clues cards with the answer (picture) on separate cards.
- A clue is read out and players compete for speed to touch the matched answer card.
 The winner is a player with the most cards.

What we do

Japan Creative Weeks (UK)

 A group of Japanese people visit primary/secondary schools for 1-3 days per school to offer Japanese cultural sessions in Kent(Feb/Mar) and London(Sep)

Karuta in Education (Aus, Worldwide)

A or pair of trained Japanese Karuta
 Coordinator(s) at primary/secondary school for 3-12 weeks to help children create their own Karuta cards and to play with them.

Creative Karuta Project (worldwide)

- An initiative to produce, use a Karuta set through a series of activities such as workshops, art competition, exhibitions and Karuta championship.
- The Hometown and Fairtrade Karuta projects were completed and the Karuta 2020 project is on going

What is Karuta 2020

- A global 4-year project to create a special karuta set to celebrate Tokyo Olympic Games, 2020 through Karuta 2020 Awards, workshops
- and to hold a Karuta Tournament in 2020
